SAMPLE LETTER TO THE EDITOR

NOTE: Writing a letter to the editor of your local newspaper or other publication can be an effective way to bring visibility to your event. You can use this template to draft a letter to the editor of your local newspaper or other media outlet, informing them of your upcoming National Cancer Survivors Day® event. Simply replace the bracketed sections below with local names and details specific to your event.

LETTER TEXT:

National Cancer Survivors Day® is Sunday, June 7, 2026. NCSA is a worldwide Celebration of Life that highlights the resilience, strength, and courage of those who have fought and continue to fight cancer. On this day, [CITY/ TOWN] will recognize the cancer survivors in our community and raise awareness of the challenges of cancer survivorship.

“A *survivor* is anyone living with a history of cancer – from the moment of diagnosis through the remainder of life,” according to the National Cancer Survivors Day Foundation, administrator for the celebration. In the United States alone, there are approximately 18.6 million people living with a history of cancer.
